Greetings Families,

The Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD), in collaboration with vision partners, is providing no-cost school-based vision services for K-12 students. The purpose of these school-based programs is to offer vision care during school hours, while students stay in school and focus on learning. Services include screening, examination, and prescription fitting program services at select schools. LAUSD K-12 students are able to receive these services unless families opt-out.

Date of Services at Our Site: September 15, 2026

WHY?

- **Early Detection of Vision Problems:** Regular vision screenings in young students can detect vision issues early, allowing for timely intervention and treatment.
- **Improvement in Academic Performance:** Good vision is essential for learning, particularly in young students who are developing literacy skills.
- **Promotion of Eye Health Habits:** Introducing vision screenings at a young age encourages the development of positive eye health habits.
- **Cost Savings:** Free student vision healthcare eliminates the financial burden associated with paying for vision screenings and eye exams out of pocket.
- **Convenience:** Free student vision healthcare will be provided on-site at schools, parents do not need to take time off and there are no missed school or workdays.

WHAT?

- FREE Screening
- FREE Examination (if initial vision screening failed)
- FREE Prescription Eyeglasses
- Referral to a vision specialist, if necessary

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- FREE vision services to students attending LAUSD K-12 schools
- Services will take place during school hours
